The committee noted that this application met the committee's criteria for funding and approved the full \$2,500 request. The committee asked the International Education Office to suggest the possible inclusion of cultural content when the trip is planned.

International Education Updates:

We have received college approval to resume study abroad. The first faculty-led program, led by Jay Antle and Lynne Beatty, will travel to Iceland in July 2022. New policies related to international travel in a covid-endemic world are being developed.
