JCCC Associate of Applied Science and K-State Polytechnic Technology Management

JCCC students can complete the Associate of Applied Science degree and then the Bachelor of Science degree from the Kansas State University Polytechnic Campus. The Technology Management option is available both on campus and fully online.

The Associate of Applied Science degree from JCCC

- is designed with an emphasis in a specific career program.
- requires completion of a minimum of 60 college-level credit hours, not to exceed 68 credit hours, within specified course distribution subgroups, including areas of emphasis, with a 2.0 or higher GPA.
- the 68-credit-hour maximum shall not apply to any programs having external accreditation or industry requirements that exceed the 68-credit-hour limit.

The total program hours necessary to complete the associate of applied science degree include 15 credit hours of general education requirements plus the courses listed for the specific career program. Please refer to your specific degree for a list of all requirements.

No more than 60 credit hours from a 2-year institution can be applied to the KSU bachelor's degree.

It is the STUDENT'S RESPONSIBILITY to check for updates to all transfer information. This transfer guide is provided as a service and is updated as needed. Degree requirements at the four-year colleges are subject to change by those institutions. To ensure you have the most accurate up to date information about the program, it is imperative you meet with an advisor at the transfer institution.
