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The Associate of Arts degree (A.A.) at JCCC is a general transfer degree and partners well with the first two years of most bachelor's degree programs. Students pursuing the A.A. may select courses that satisfy both the A.A. degree requirements and lower division requirements for a bachelor's degree at four-year institutions. The elective hours within the A.A. allow students to complete additional general education and lower division courses required for specific majors. The A.A. degree requires completion of 60 credit hours; please see JCCC A.A. degree requirements. Meeting with a JCCC counselor is strongly recommended for selection of appropriate courses.

- The bachelor's degree in sport management at the University of Kansas prepares students for a variety of positions in the sport and athletics industry: professional athletics, intercollegiate athletics, as well as other sport and health-related organizations.
- Students can be admitted into the Sport Management program as transfer students if they are admitted to KU, declare Sport Management as their major, and meet the following criteria:
 - A KU + Transfer Cumulative GPA of at least 2.75
- For information about initial admission to KU, visit the <u>Office of Admissions</u>. Visit the <u>Office of International Support Services</u> for information about international admissions.
- Prospective Sport Management students should consult an advisor early in the first year to plan efficient programs of study.
- Students must complete at least one of the four minors: Athletics Coaching; Business; Journalism and Mass Communications; or Psychology.
- Seventy-five credits may be transferred to KU from community colleges. Students should be aware that 45
 junior/senior credit hours are required for completion of the bachelor's degree; 30 of those hours must be at KU; and
 community college courses do not transfer as junior/senior hours.
- A student must earn a grade of C- or higher in KU CORE 34 written and oral communication courses and quantitative literacy courses, as well as HSES 289.
- Only 6 hours of Credit/No Credit is allowed for general education courses. A student cannot take a class Credit/No Credit for any major requirement.
- Minimum total hours for graduation is 120.
- Effective Fall 2024: Students transferring to KU, with an AA, AFA or AS degree from JCCC will be considered to have satisfied KU's Core 34 general education curriculum.
- Effective Fall 2024: Students who transfer to KU, without completing AA, AFA or AS degree will have courses evaluated on a course-by-course basis toward meeting KU requirements.
